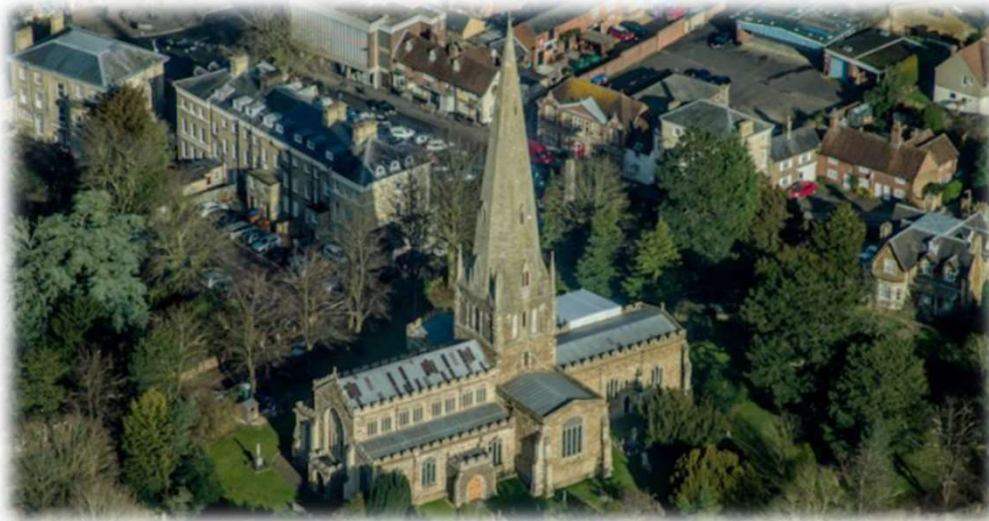




TREE TRAIL

Key

1. Chinese Arborvitae (*Platycladus orientalis*, synonym *Thuja orientalis*)
2. Copper Beech (*Fagus sylvatica* var. *purpurea*)
3. Common or European Limes (*Tilia × europaea*, synonym *T. vulgaris*)
4. Double-stemmed Turkey Oak (*Quercus cerris*)
5. Corsican Black Pine (*Pinus nigra*)
6. Scots Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*)
7. Two female berrying Hollies (*Ilex aquifolium*)
8. Mountain Ash or Rowan (*Sorbus aucuparia*)
9. Norway Maple (*Acer platanoides*)
10. Horse Chestnut (*Aesculus hippocastanum*)
11. Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus* 'Atropurpureum')
12. Sweet Chestnut (*Castanea sativa*)
13. Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*)
14. Spruces (*Picea* species)
15. Box (*Buxus sempervirens*)
16. Serbian Spruce (*Picea omorica*)
17. Irish Yew (*Taxus baccata* 'Fastigiata')
18. Californian Redwood (*Sequoia sempervirens*)
19. Cork Oak (*Quercus suber*)
20. Atlas Cedar (*Cedrus atlantica* 'Glauca')
21. Incense Cedar (*Calocedrus decurrens*)
22. English Oak (*Quercus robur*)
23. Spreading Yew (*Taxus cuspidata*)
24. Laburnum (*Laburnum × wateri*)
25. Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*)
26. Magnolia × soulangiana
27. Deodar Cedar (*Cedrus deodara*)
28. Nootka Cypress (*Xanthocyparis nootkatensis*)
