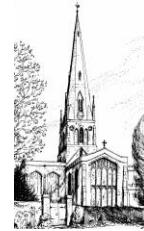

BIKE 'n HIKE SAT. 14TH SEPTEMBER 2019: Put this date in your diaries **NOW**. I hope I don't need to remind you how much All Saints owes to the Beds Herts Historic Churches Trust. Last year there were lots of promises but I was the only one who did a sponsored walk of 19km. I've just been informed that I raised £621.75 after Gift Aid was added, so again very many thanks to my sponsors. This means that All Saints has been awarded a Bronze Certificate for raising more than £500. Overall Bike'nHike raised over £96,000 which can be distributed to historic churches throughout the two counties. Last year, All Saints, Southill, Beds had received a grant of £8,000 so they organised a sponsored **car tour** visiting 62 churches between 10am and 6pm and raised a magnificent £2,321. This is new concept which makes use of the fact the over 600 churches are open and available for visits. Please give a thought to the people who man these churches. It must be soul destroying if not many people visit. So if you don't want to walk or ride a bike, please consider a similar car tour to raise money. This year let's have a variety of sponsored volunteer walkers, cyclists, riders and motorists from schools, youth groups, families, choirs, friendship groups etc. etc. and make sure that All Saints, Leighton Buzzard raises an amount to be proud of.
