
LUNCH CLUB: Lunch Club on Ist April has been cancelled. Tickets will be carried over to the next occasion but refunds are available if preferred.

On the 17th of March the Archbishops of Canterbury and York took the decision to suspend public worship in the Church of England until further notice so there will be no services for people to attend at this time.

Even though it is not possible for people to attend, clergy and lay ministers will be offering regular services of Holy Communion on behalf of the community. If you normally attend worship, you might like to pray at home at the time that you would normally come to church, knowing that others will be doing the same. In this way we can continue to pray together even though we cannot meet in person.

We hope to be able to broadcast the 9:15am service this Sunday, 22nd March, to our Facebook page "All Saints', Leighton Buzzard" and will be looking at other ways of reaching out with opportunities for prayer and worship.
