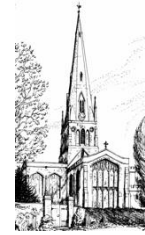

NEW ENGLISH HYMNAL

Collect for Sunday: Almighty God, you called Luke the physician, whose praise is in the gospel, to be an evangelist and physician of the soul; by the grace of the Spirit and through the wholesome medicine of the gospel, give your Church the same love and power to heal; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Collect for weekday services: God, the giver of life, whose Holy Spirit wells up within your Church; by the Spirit's gifts equip us to live the gospel of Christ and make us eager to do your will, that we may share with the whole creation the joys of eternal life; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Psalm: 147 vv. 1-7

Response: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me.

O praise the Lord, for it is good to sing praises to our God: and to praise him is joyful and right. The Lord is rebuilding Jerusalem: he is gathering together the scattered outcasts of Israel. He heals the broken in spirit: and binds up their wounds.

He counts the number of the stars: and calls them all by name. Great is our Lord: and great is his power: there is no measuring his understanding.

The Lord restores the humble: but he brings down the wicked to the dust. O sing to the Lord a song of thanksgiving: sing praises to our God upon the harp.
